

EASTER 2019

8:00 Service

Set up with pottery like a normal service

½ cup of wine, 1 can grape juice

100 wafers

10:30 Festival Service

Set up with silver like a normal service

2-1/2 Cups of Wine, 2 cans grape juice

200-250 wafers, as many as you can fit into the silver ciborium

Service set-up, in addition to the typical service set up

- Change altar hangings to the Thompson white altar vestments. Change the Children's altar to white and drape the cross on the Children's altar in white
- The cross above the altar is draped in white
- The Paschal candle is placed in the center, in front of the altar. Make sure it is filled
- Put out the baptismal font. Fill it with blessed water if there is no baptism
- Make sure all candles are filled
- Replace flags (Christian flag by chapel, American flag by choir)
- Put up Easter banner
- Put a full sanctuary oil candle in the holder beside the ambry
- Replace altar party hymnals and prayer books
- Reset chapel and children's altars
- Set service checklists out on the counter
- Set a sleeve of unconsecrated wafers on the sacristy counter in case extra are needed

After Easter services:

1. Restock the large, PVLEM and Priest's communion kits, using consecrated wine and wafers from Easter services.
2. Leave the Paschal candle out through Pentecost. Fill it weekly.
