

## EASTER 2023

### 8:00 Service

Set up with pottery like a normal service  
( $\frac{1}{2}$  cup wine, 1 can grape juice)

50 wafers

### 10:30 Festival Service

Set up with silver like a normal service  
(2- $\frac{1}{2}$  cups wine, 2 cans grape juice).

200-250 wafers, as many as you can fit into the silver ciborium.

### Service set-up, in addition to the typical service set up

- Change altar hangings to the Thompson white altar vestments.
- The cross above the altar is draped in white
- The Paschal candle is placed in the center, in front of the altar.  
Make sure it is filled.
- Put out the baptismal font. Fill it with blessed water if there is no baptism
- Make sure all candles are filled .
- Replace flags (Christian flag by chapel, American flag by choir).
- Put up Easter banner.
- Put a full sanctuary oil candle in the holder beside the ambry.
- Replace altar party hymnals and prayer books.
- Set service checklists out on the counter.
- Set a sleeve of unconsecrated wafers on the sacristy counter in case extra are needed.
- Make sure the wooden cross is out front for flowering.

### After Easter services:

1. Restock the Priest's communion kits, using consecrated wine and wafers from Easter services.
2. Leave the Paschal candle out through Pentecost. Fill it weekly.
